

Three Minute Thesis Competition at Université Laval (CAGS-2023) and (NAGS-2023)

General presentation of the competition

Three Minute Thesis Competition allows PhD students to present their research topic in simple terms to a diverse and novice audience. In three minutes, the challenge is to present complex research in an accessible and compelling way with the assistance of only static slide.

Organization of faculty competitions

For the English-speaking final, the Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies invites each faculty to submit a ULaval candidate who is enrolled or who has been enrolled in a thesis-based graduate program (Master or PhD) during the current academic year (September 2022 to August 2023). The Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies encourages faculties to hold a faculty final and to read the eligibility rules for the competition on the CAGS website.

The deadline to send the FESP the name and contact information for the finalist is March 15, 2023.

CAGS competition

Université Laval will compete in the Eastern Canada Final. Following the final, the first three winners will compete in the Canadian Association for Graduate Studies (CAGS) Canadian final.

NAGS competition

The winner of the Université Laval 1st Prize will also participate in the competition that will take place at the Northeastern Association of Graduate Schools (NAGS) annual meeting.
