## General presentation of the competition

Three Minute Thesis Competition allows PhD students to present their research topic in simple terms to a diverse and secular audience. In three minutes, each participant must give a clear, concise and convincing presentation on his research project.

## Organization of faculty competitions

For the English-speaking final, the Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (FESP) invites each faculty to submit a ULaval candidate who has been enrolled or who has been enrolled in a Master or a PhD research program with a thesis during the current academic year (September 2024 to August 2025). The Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies encourages faculties to hold a faculty final and to read the eligibility rules for the competition on the CAGS website.

#### The deadline to send the FESP the name and contact information for the candidate is March 14, 2025.

#### CAGS competition

Université Laval will compete in the Eastern Canada Final. Following the final, the first three winners will compete in the Canadian Association for Graduate Studies (CAGS) Canadian final.

### NAGS competition

The winner of the Université Laval 1st Prize will also participate in the competition that will take place at the Northeastern Association of Graduate Schools (NAGS) annual meeting.
