



Additional questions to deepen your reflection and complete your logbook

The following questions can accompany your reflection at each stage or activity of the research. Specific questions can be added to better reflect the nature of your research.

- What generative AI tools am I using in this part of my research?
- What are my motivations? Examples: easier access to data, efficiency, speed, search for sources of inspiration.
- Descriptions of uses. Examples: main objectives of iterations (generate, improve, or compare ideas), data integrated into tools, etc.
- What are the advantages of using AI in this part of my research?
- What are the limitations of using AI in this part of my research?
- Does the use of AI raise ethical questions or dilemmas in this part of my research? If so, what are they?
- What precautions am I taking to ensure that these uses comply with academic standards, particularly with regard to:
 - Double-checking AI-generated data
 - Being transparent about the uses of AI
 - Respecting the confidentiality of personal data
 - Protecting and respecting copyright
 - Maintaining the development of my research skills
- I will mention (or have mentioned) these uses of AI in my master's or doctoral thesis, specifically:
 - In the methodology section
 - In a footnote
 - In the appendices
 - In the bibliography
